

UTTO Data protection policy

UTTO Inc. and IPEG Corporation and its subsidiaries and partner companies (hereinafter referred to jointly and singly as “UTTO”) consider the protection of your business and personal data to be of great importance. UTTO will collect, process and use the data that it collects in the course of your visit to its website and mobile applications (hereinafter referred to as the “Website” or “App”). In doing so it will comply with the principles described below as well as with the provisions of the Fair Information Practice.

1. Your personal & Company data

Data consists of information regarding personal or Company information. Such data includes, for example, your name, your telephone number as well as your physical and e-mail addresses, information entered during Login or Sign-Up. Data also includes field captures such as images and GPS coordinates of assets.

UTTO maintains reasonable and appropriate security measures to protect data from loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. No data is shared with 3rd parties.

2. Collection and use of your personal data

When you visit the Website, your data will only be collected if you register at the Website or App. If you do not register during your visit or conclude a contract at our Website or install the App, no personal data will be collected or used.

While visiting our Website, you will be requested to supply data at various times. We collect and use this data

- to create a customer account for you
- to display information on Website or App
- to take and process your order
- to collect outstanding receivables
- to receive and process your enquiries
- if you have granted your consent separately, also to send you newsletters

Additionally,

a) Information regarding the use of your personal data to create your customer account UTTO will use the data that you enter while registering at its Website. It will use your name (first name and last), address, telephone number, e-mail address and Company name and position. Its use of this information will be limited to that which is necessary to conclude a contract with you or define or amend the terms of same.

b) Information about the use of your Company or personal data to process your enquiries;

UTTO also collects and uses your data when handling suggestions and comments that you submit on a contact form at its Website.

c) Use of your data for sending you newsletters

If you expressly consent, UTTO will use your personal data, in particular your name (first name and surname), your address, your telephone number, your e-mail address so that it can continue sending you updates on new developments at no obligation.

3. Cookies and automatically collected technical information

The Website also uses what are known as cookies. Cookies are small text files which are stored by your browser on your hard disc. We use the information in the cookies to make your online visit more productive. In addition, we use cookies to You can deactivate the cookies function in your browser. We should point out, however, that this could mean that you will not be able to access some areas of our Website or that they will not function properly.

4. Length of time that your Company or personal data will be stored and disclosure, updating and deletion of this data. As a matter of principle, UTTO will not store your data any longer than necessary for the purposes stated in these data protection provisions or to comply with any relevant statutory duty to archive or otherwise keep records. Upon your request and at no charge to you, UTTO will disclose to you the data it has stored regarding your Company or person, the use of this data and the related processing.
